To Whom It May Concern:

My name is Deacon Thomas McNally and I am the Chaplain/Coordinator for a program at the Cathedral of the Assumption known as the Cathedral of the Assumption ID Assistance Program.

For the last five years that I have been at the cathedral, we have received an annual grant from the Department of Community Services of the Louisville Metro Government that assists individuals who are homeless or in danger of homelessness and who lack sufficient funds to obtain critical personal identification through the Kentucky Department of Motor Vehicles via a vouchered system.

This is a unique program in that there is no other known program in our area that is specific to this service.

We receive our clients mostly through our daily lunch program but also through referrals from agencies which require the need for their clients to have these vital credentials. However, we feel that there are many agencies that may not be aware of this Program and service to the community.

This communication is to alert you to this Program and provide your agency with the basic requirements required by the Department of Motor Vehicles needed in order to obtain this credential through our vouchered system (see attachment).

It must be stated that our annual grant is for a limited amount specific to the cost for identifications and for that purpose only (i.e. personal Kentucky identification). The ID vouchers are issued on an appointment basis on the first and third Monday of the month at 9 A.M. sharp. Appointments can be made by calling 502-582-2971, leaving client name and number specifying the ID Program. A return call will be made to set an appointment time and date. Again, this Program is for those who are homeless or in danger of homelessness whose financial means are nil or extremely limited.

DOCUMENTS NEEDED FOR A KENTUCKY ID CARD

Yes! I have had an ID or Driver's License in Kentucky in the past 5 years.
I need to bring with me: TWO DOCUMENTS WITH MY NAME AND SIGNATURE ON THEM.

Examples:

Medicare/Medicaid/Passport Card	Coalition for Homeless ID	School Transcript

***Photocopies of any official document Do Not Qualify!**

I need to bring with me:

My Birth Certificate or ID/Driver's License from another state.

And My Social Security Card

And Proof of Residency
